Students are encouraged to use this opportunity for guidance on future research directions.

In addition, we provide opportunities to:

- present the work to the whole conference audience at the poster session,
- receive a best paper award, and,
- network and discuss ideas during and after the workshop.

This call is open to all papers mainly authored by students (Bachelor, Master or PhD) and covering topics related to genetic and evolutionary computation. Workshop papers will be published in the GECCO Companion Proceedings.
